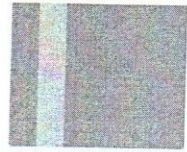

Sub: APSSDC- Student Skill Improvement Program -Enrolment of students - payment of Registration fees- Financial support by the Institute-Reg.

It may kindly be referred to the previous note submitted from SDC (copy enclosed) regarding the APSSDC mandate of the enrolment of students for Student Skill Improvement Programs as a must for sanctioning the new laboratories being planned by them, where in a direction is given by the Secretary & Correspondent to start the training sessions.

APSSDC has planned different training programs across branches and years of study. They are planned from 9.30 to 12.30pm on Tuesdays and Wednesdays for Final years and on Thursdays and Fridays for third years. And from 1.30 to 4.30 pm on Tuesdays and Wednesdays for first years and on Thursdays and Fridays for second years.


Registration fee for fourth years is Rs. 2,000/-, for third years it is Rs. 1,500/-, for second years it is Rs. 1,000/- and for first years it is Rs.500/-. The registration is free for all SC and ST students of all years.

In view of the need for mandated registrations and to encourage/ motivate the students for these training programs, it is proposed to make the registration compulsory for all the students of some years of study (if not for all years of study, at least for two years of study, basing on the feasibility, from each branch) and to pay 50% of the registration fees for all the non-SC & ST students by the Institute.



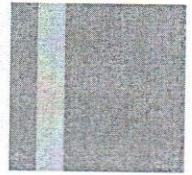

Sub: APSSDC- UIF Program - Payment of Fees of \$ 4,000 - Registration- Reg.

Kindly find attached the concept note on selection of Institutions for "Stanford University Innovation Fellows" program. Also find attached the approval given for the payment of registration fees of \$ 4,000 for the same program.

Regarding this payment, APSSDC & Google have come up with a policy that \$ 4,000 will be reimbursed by Google for those colleges which are registering for the first time and only \$ 1,000 will be reimbursed by APSSDC. In either case, the institutes need to pay the amount upfront and submit a request seeking the reimbursement.

The training program for the candidates accepted into the program will commence from Sept 5, 2017 and will up to October 20, 2017. Four students (two students from CSE, one from ECE and one from ME Branches) who have applied for the program are interviewed and are accepted into the program.

It is expected that the timing of the visit of the team to Stanford University for Spring Season may clash with the semester end examinations. When discussed with APPSSDC regarding this problem, it is assured that once the registration is done with payment, it can be utilized in either of the seasons - Spring or Fall, even if registration is done for the Spring.

The payment need to be done online with credit / debit card.

With the above, I request that it may kindly be permitted to pay the amount of money equivalent to \$ 4,000 by using my debit card and claim it later.
